Digital Photos – up to Fifty (50) Points

1. Each entry must include a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 20 digital color photographs on a disk. Entries submitted without digital color photographs will not be considered.

- Suggestions for Pictures
 - a) Ensure that digital photographs are clean, crisp and depict the project in the best possible manner- taking into account lighting and the overall impact of the project.
 - b) Make sure digital photographs capture the complexity, the aesthetic appeal and the craftsmanship of the project.
 - c) Include additional digital photographs that depict any other relevant feature(s) of the project for the judges to consider.

Narrative – Up to Forty Five (45) Points

The Project Narrative should include:

1. Commentary that customer expectations were met or exceeded.
2. Alignment with the PDCA Industry Standards, where applicable.
3. Any other relevant information for the judges to consider.
4. Discussion of topics such as unique application, sequencing, and time constraints when the project is primarily a large scale protection coating application.

VI. Extra scoring points may be earned as follows:

Five (5) Points - PDCA Accredited Company

VII. Point System Judging:

Judges will score each submission using the attached criteria. Each submission will be assigned a point total, the highest of which will determine the award recipient. Judges at their sole discretion will select the award recipient in case of ties.
